* Must be **enrolled and/or accepted to college** for Spring 2022 and/or Fall 2022 of applicant's choice (proof of acceptance required)

* Applicants must:

- Have a minimum GPA of 3.0
- A financial need
- Plan to attend a 2 or 4-year college or technical school.
- A Colorado Resident
- Identify as a woman of color

* Scholarship funds will be paid **during the enrolled semester directly to the college** and not to the student.
